Public Health Nurse services include:

- ◆ Immunization:
 - In BC, vaccinations are offered free of charge to protect children from 12 different diseases.
 - Vaccines in the first two years are given at 2, 4, 6, 12, and 18 mo.
 - Immunization is a cornerstone of health protection.
- ◆ Prenatal information
- ◆ Supports for new mothers
 - Breast feeding support
 - Postpartum depression support and resources
- ◆ Services for children with special needs
- ◆ Providing health information and screening (Including development, health and safety)
- ◆ Referral and resources for nutrition, parenting, healthy lifestyles.
